If you want to see a wildlife sanctuary in the wilderness, come to the north Georgia mountains this Sunday for a guided tour. This educational hike covers over a mile of up-and-down terrain to see mountain lions, panthers, black bears, deer, raccoons, and even spiders and snakes. Right now we have two very young raccoons and two adults that are just too cute to miss.
